VIP Section Access


- The VIP viewing area will be located on the Base Lodge second floor deck, with great views of the stage.

Weekly Construction Update

Projects taking place within the Granby Ranch neighborhood are listed below. Check back for weekly updates.



The map above illustrates the path for a temporary road, which has been put in place so utilities can be installed under Lake Drive.



- Repair work on Lake Drive at Lower Ranch View will begin today (Monday 8/15). Only one lane of traffic will be open while they are performing the deep repair. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic. Goal is for both lanes to be restored by end of the day. Asphalt paving is tentatively scheduled for Thursday 8/18.
- Tuesday 8/16 the removal & repair work will begin on Lake Dr. at Cirrus & Eagles Nest Ct. continuing up Lake toward the new construction at Nighthawk. Paving for all of Lake Dr. should hopefully be completed by the end of day Friday 8/19.
- Work on Nimbus & Stratus should begin the week of 8/22.
- The sanitary sewer road crossing at Lake Dr. near Nighthawk will be completed by Friday 8/19.

Maximum Services, Inc. is the general contractor and they will be on-site daily. We will make every effort to minimize the impact on all residents and their guests during the repair process and give you updates on any scheduling changes that may occur.

Upgrades to the Granby Ranch entryway signage are complete - all pillars have been leveled off and capped.

Fraser Canyon Trail Relocation Update



Fraser Canyon Trail Re-route Recommended route - base to summit

Access the Fraser Canyon Trail at the Log Cabin, located at 999 Village Rd. Proceed on to the Ike's trail split and go right. Take Ike's trail to Kicking Horse junction then take a left and continue on Ike's Trail/Home Again.

Proceed on Ike's trail/Home Again over the "fly over" bridge. Take a right just before the yurt and proceed onto the Fraser Canyon trail to the Summit.

Note: the 'out and back' is temporary, until construction in Filing 8 is completed.


