As the ski season winds down, we are very happy to see the amount of interest for the upcoming golf season at Granby Ranch.

Below are a few of the most frequently asked questions.

I don't see the word "member" used anymore. Are we still members at Granby Ranch?

The term "member" was very confusing. There were different benefit options as well as an "Elevated Golf" option. Additionally, there was confusion when there were multiple owners of one property. There are now three benefit packages available at Granby Ranch:

- **Full Benefit Homeowner or FBH** This is a comprehensive benefits package that is associated with each property. It can include two adults (a primary and secondary) and up to two children under the age of 26. (dependents).
- Full Benefit Homeowner Add-On or FBHA This is an
 individual package that is available to family members or other
 people on the property deed. It includes a season ski pass, access
 to Ranch Hall, use of the Property Owners ski lane, eligibility to
 play in the Roundup golf tournament and discounted green fees.
 The current cost of this membership is \$550 for anyone over the
 age of 26 and \$250 under 26.
- Limited Benefit Homeowner or LBH This is a limited benefits package that has been "grandfathered" in and is no longer available. This package does not include ski passes, the use of Ranch Hall, golf passes, or discounted green fees. LBH's can upgrade to an FBH package.

How many free rounds of golf do we receive as a Granby Ranch property owner?

• **FBH:** (8) free rounds of golf. These can be used by the primary, secondary and dependents. The rounds can be used by friends, but one of the FBH individuals must be present. They are 18-hole rounds and cannot be split into (16) nine hole rounds.

FBHA: No free roundsLBH: No free rounds

What is the cost of a round of golf after my free rounds have been used?

• FBH and FBHA: \$45 any day before 2:00 and \$35 after 2:00

• LBH: Rack rate green fees.

Is there an unlimited golf option?

Yes, for FBH and FBHA property owners. The cost is \$400 for an individual or \$900 for a family. If a couple without kids purchases this option, it would be \$800.

Who is eligible to play in the Roundup as a "Member"?


You must be an FBH or FBHA to play as the "member" partner.

Is there a women's flight in the Roundup?

The flights are based on handicaps to be competitive with other players of similar abilities regardless of gender. However, if there is enough interest in a women's flight, the committee will consider this.

Can you pair me up if I can't find a partner?

Probably. While the tournament committee cannot guarantee that a partner will be found, every effort will be made to match up singles.

Homeowner Clinics

One clinic will be held on the first Sunday of every month (starting in June) at 10am. There will be a different focus for every clinic: driving, irons, short game, and putting.

A Message From Your Bike/Hike And Open Space Committee



Save the Date! Saturday, June 8th 8:00am to 12:00pm

In an effort to be good stewards of the beautiful surroundings we have here at Granby Ranch, the Bike/Hike & Open Space committee, in conjunction with the new Granby Ranch ownership team, is organizing the fourth annual Granby Ranch clean-up day on Saturday, June 8th, 2024. We are looking for volunteers to help clean-up our neighborhoods, trails, roads and open spaces from 8am – 12:00pm. We will be providing trash bags to volunteers as well as having a "roll-off" trash container available. Afterwards, lunch will be provided for all volunteers at the Bluebird Bistro from 12:00pm-1:00pm.

Trash bags can be picked up at the site of the "roll-off", located near the entrance of the base lodge parking lot. Please pick-up any trash along roads (in culverts), vacant lots, trails, open space... and place in trash bags. If items are too large/heavy for trash bags leave by the side of the road and they will be picked up. Place trash bags at the end of the street closest to Village/Lake Dr. and they will be picked up. Or bring trash bags to where the "roll-off" trash receptacle is located. Recyclable items (excluding glass) can be placed in the recycle bins at the Base Lodge.

In addition, any large trash items that you may personally need to dispose of can be placed in the "roll-off" container as long as they meet the following requirements: **No TV's, CPU's, Monitors, printers/faxes, laptop/tablets,**

DVD/VCRs, Radios, or Video game consoles. No Hazardous Waste or Toxic Waste. No Liquid Waste. No Refrigerators or Freezers. No Household chemicals. No Car batteries. No Petroleum Products. No Contaminated Soil. You must bring your Granby Ranch homeowner pass in order to dispose of personal items.
